Firstly, hope you are back in the States safely. A couple updates on our conversation a couple weeks ago:

As far as to whether the complainants would see your response, technically the complainant is Steve Pellinen, not Lola, Jennifer or Evans. However, regardless of whether your response will be shared with one of them (not sure if Steve would, but he might), you should know that your response could be subpoenaed and disclosed to someone pursuing a criminal and/or civil case against you.

If, however, we get the info and decide we can hear the case before July 7th (and resolve in your favor), then you can play in the SPC.
