# UTCR 19.050 STATEMENT

This contempt proceeding arises from and is related to Multnomah County Circuit Court Case No. 23CV15424, *David Koenig vs Jennifer Clinchy, Evans Clinchy, & Brianna (Lola) McKissen*.

On April 14, 2023, David Koenig filed a legally baseless complaint in Case No. 23CV15424 against Jennifer and Evans Clinchy. The complaint sought \$485,000 in purported damages based on statements made by Jennifer and Evans Clinchy in a disciplinary proceeding with the North American Scrabble Players Association concerning David Koenig's conduct.

On September 5, 2023, this Court granted Jennifer and Evans Clinchy's special motion to strike and dismissed David Koenig's legally baseless complaint in its entirety.

On March 19, 2024, this Court entered a supplemental judgment and money award in favor of Jennifer and Evans Clinchy against David Koenig. On June 26, 2024, this Court entered an order requiring David Koenig to attend a debtor's exam and to answer written interrogatories pertaining to his financial condition by July 16, 2024.

#### UTCR 5.050 STATEMENT

Jennifer and Evans Clinchy do not expect the evidentiary hearing and oral argument will exceed 30 minutes. Jennifer and Evans Clinchy request official court reporting services.

### **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

Under ORS 33.055 and this Court's inherent authority, Jennifer and Evans Clinchy respectfully move for an order requiring David Koenig to appear at a proceeding to show cause why the Court should not impose remedial sanctions for David Koenig's alleged contempt of this Court's June 26, 2024 order.

Under UTCR 19.020, the maximum remedial sanction sought is a per diem fine of \$50.00 per day until David Koenig complies with this Court's June 26, 2024 order. Jennifer and Evans Clinchy do not seek a sanction of confinement at this time.

Under ORS 33.055(2)(a), Jennifer and Evans Clinchy may initiate and participate in this proceeding because they are parties aggrieved by David Koenig's alleged contempt of Court.

The attached documentation and following facts are sufficient to give David Koenig notice of the specific acts alleged to constitute his contempt under ORS 33.055(4), specifically:

(a) David Koenig's disobedience of and resistance to this Court's June 26, 2024 order by David Koenig's refusal as a witness to answer questions at his debtor's exam under ORS 33.015(2)(b) and (c); and
(b) David Koenig's disobedience of and resistance to this Court's June 26, 2024 order by David Koenig's refusal to produce interrogatory responses under ORS 33.015(2)(b) and (d).

After David Koenig is served with an order directing him to appear under ORS 33.055(5)(a), and after affording David Koenig an opportunity for a hearing tried to the Court under ORS 33.055(6), and after informing David Koenig of the right to counsel under ORS 33.055(9), and after David Koenig's contempt is proved by clear and convincing evidence under ORS 33.055(11), Jennifer and Evans Clinchy respectfully request an order holding David Koenig in contempt of this Court's June 26, 2024 order, and an order imposing a "remedial sanction" under ORS 33.015(4) of a per diem "fine" of \$50.00 per day as permitted by ORS 33.045(3)(b) and (4) payable to Jennifer and Evans Clinchy until David Koenig complies with the Court's June

26, 2024 order by answering questions at a debtor's exam pertaining to his financial condition and producing written interrogatory responses.

At evidentiary hearing, Jennifer and Evans Clinchy, through counsel, will prove with clear and convincing evidence that David Koenig refused to answer questions at his debtor's exam on July 8, 2024, and instead read from a prepared statement from his blog, in violation of this Court's June 26, 2024 order. *See* Exhibit 1.

Clear and convincing evidence will also show that David Koenig has refused to answer written interrogatories, in violation of this Court's June 26, 2024 order. *Id.* 

Clear and convincing evidence will also establish that David Koenig's violations of this Court's June 26, 2024 order are knowing and willful. In a blog posted on the Internet dated July 8, 2024, David Koenig acknowledged that Jennifer and Evans Clinchy had filed a "motion to the court to compel me to come in for a hearing to answer questions about my assets and income." *See* Exhibit 1.

David Koenig's blog post continued his disparagement of Judge Kelly Skye, his prior counsel, and Jennifer and Evans Clinchy's counsel, and directly challenged this Court's authority, stating: "I am not willing to do that, regardless of whatever punishment the court might put on me for refusing to comply." *Id*.

## CONCLUSION

Under these circumstances, Jennifer and Evans Clinchy respectfully request that the Court issue an order requiring David Koenig to appear at a proceeding to impose remedial sanctions for contempt, and after David Koenig's contempt is proved by clear and convincing evidence, an order holding David Koenig in contempt, and imposing a per diem fine of \$50.00 per day until David Koenig complies with this Court's June 26, 2024 order, in addition to any other equitable relief the Court may determine is fair and just under the circumstances.
